PHONICS

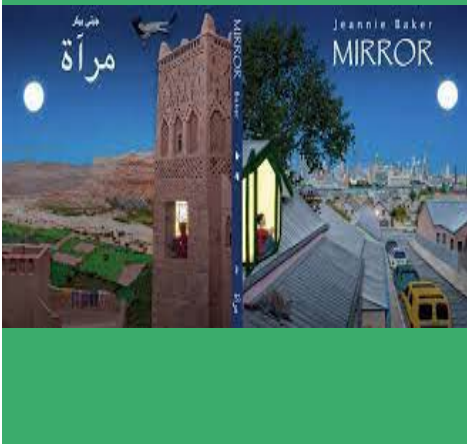

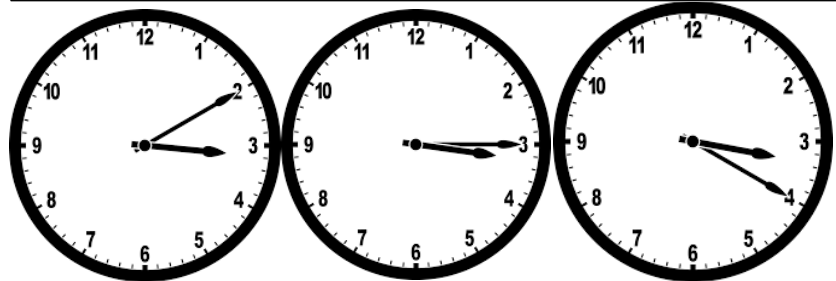
