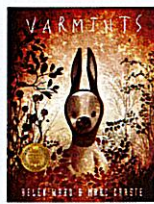
UPCOMING PARENT EVENTS

Year 5 SPORTS DAY!

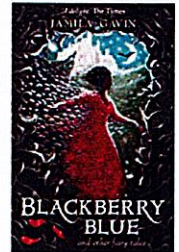

CORE SUBJECTS



Reading – In reading we will be practising our inference and retrieval skills by focusing on the text Varmints

Writing – In writing we are going to be re-telling fairy tales with a modern twist, based on the book Blackberry Blue.



Maths – In maths we are going to be continuing our work on fractions, before moving onto learning about decimals and how to calculate with them. We will then be moving on to properties of shape where we will learn to measure angles.

Geography – In geography, we will be learning all about the water cycle and finding out why water is so important to us and what we can do to preserve it!

Science - In Science, we will be continuing our learning about animals and their habitats. We will be looking at the different places animals live and thinking about why certain habitats are suited to different animals.
