Hovingham's Curriculum

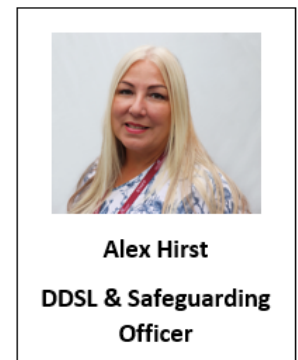
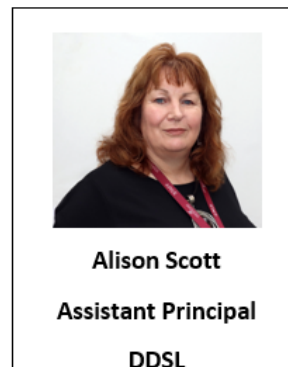
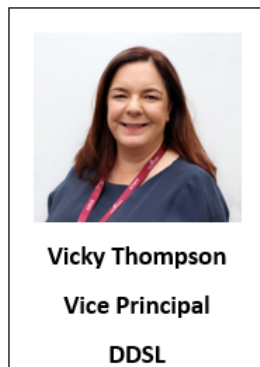
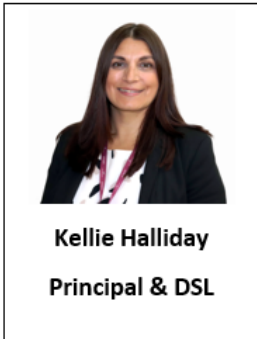
